INFORMATION FOR VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Be Prepared Make a Safety Plan:

1. Leave your home before you are abused or the violence gets worse, if you feel you are in danger. You may do that without losing the right to return home. If you leave for safety reasons, you cannot be accused of desertion.
2. Know the telephone number of your police department.
3. Try not to leave without your children (but see # 1).
4. Set aside an "emergency" bag for yourself and your children which includes changes of clothing, important papers; such as, birth certificates, social security cards, public assistance cards, health ins. cards, etc.
5. Put aside money for this emergency as well as checks, bank books, bank cards, and credit cards to joint accounts. You are entitled to take money from all jointly held bank accounts.
6. Make an extra set of keys to the house and car and keep them hidden.
7. Do not keep your abuse a secret. Confide in family members or friends and ask for their help.
8. Contact your local domestic violence program for emotional support and information on 24-hour assistance and temporary safe shelter.

INTRODUCTION

ICADV pursues a vision where all people engage in healthy relationships characterized by the mutual sharing of resources, responsibilities and affection; where youth are nurtured with those expectations; and where all people are supported within a society committed to equality in relationships and equity in opportunity as fundamental human rights.

The Indiana Coalition *Against* Domestic Violence (ICADV) is a not-for-profit corporation that works to eliminate domestic violence through the implementation of prevention programs including public education, advocacy for system and societal change, influencing public policy and allocation of resources. Until the violence is ended, ICADV works to promote, strengthen and provide quality comprehensive services for member programs and all individuals affected by domestic violence across the state.

The residential and non-residential programs that are outlined in this directory primarily provide services to female victims of domestic violence and their children. All programs will provide services either on-site or via referral to male victims of domestic violence, victims of rape, homeless persons, and batterers. The services offered by all residential and most non-residential programs are free of charge. Each program can be contacted to find out what services it provides.

There are many resources available to crime victims and their families throughout the state of Indiana.
