- Tuition reciprocity in postsecondary education, is a mutual exchange of in-state tuition privilege for specific geographical areas outside of a state.
- The Indiana Commission for Higher Education has authority to create reciprocity agreements (IC 21-18-12.2-1).



MSEP



- Began in 1994 through the Midwest Higher Education Compact (MHEC)
- Public institutions agree to charge students no more than 150% of the in-state resident tuition rate for specific programs; private institutions offer a 10% reduction on their tuition rates.
- About 100 colleges and universities in Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota and Wisconsin
- MSEP is a voluntary program and only nine of the twelve states participate. Iowa, South Dakota, and Ohio do not participate in MSEP at this time.
