

## Drug-Free Workplace Program Funding Announcement

The *Paul D. Coverdell Drug-Free Workplace* (DFWP) Grant was created to provide technical and financial assistance services to small businesses that implement drug-free workplace programs. To help small businesses benefit from being drug-free, **Drug-Free Hoosiers** will provide assistance with the costs of implementing a DFWP.

With 75% of drug users working, users significantly contribute to increased medical costs, disability insurance costs, absenteeism rates, employee theft, accidents, as well as decreased employee morale, productivity and product quality. It is through grants like the Coverdell DFWP that we will build a more capable, alert, and safety-conscious work force across Indiana.

Over the two year life of the grant, small manufacturing companies will receive free employee, supervisory and working parent training, testing services set-up, reduced-fee drug tests, free human resource consulting, free employee assistance programming, and a free drug-free comprehensive workplace toolkit with policy and forms templates including payroll stuffers and EAP informational resources across Indiana.
