Saturday, Feb 18 – Fur Trader Story: Living History \$3

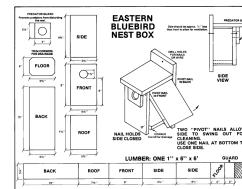
Sit back and listen to this interactive story telling of a time gone by. Make and take home item too.
