1) Supplemental Compensation based on Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) table SA06N – “Compensation of employees by NAICS industry-Indiana”. The supplemental rate is the Ratio of “Total Supplements to wages and salaries” to “Total wage and salary disbursements”. The resulting supplemental rate calculation is 0.2556. Supplemental Compensation is the application of the supplemental rate (0.2556) applied to the current Median OES wage for each occupation.
