Melanie--- CCDF Reauthorization

- -Federal laws are changing for funding
- -Indiana is required to meet new requirements.
- -New regulations will be promulgated for homes, centers and ministries
- -CCDF is going from 6 months to 12 months for eligible children

Phase out policy (cliff effect) 127% poverty level up to 170%

Families stay on longer with increasing co pays

All providers will have unannounced visits from state licensing rep.

New State law for unlicensed CCDF vouchers started July 1st.
