What is a Waiver Amendment?

- Changes/updates to Medicaid Waivers require approval by the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)
- CMS requires 90-day Review period for their review
- Request for Additional Information (RAI)
- CMS has 90 days to approve/disapprove



What is Public Notice and Comment?

- Proposed rule, policy, or guidance is published and open to the public
- Occurs prior to submitting amendment to Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)
- Ensures that everyone has the opportunity to share thoughts, concerns, or questions



Why Public Comment?

Required by Federal Law (42 CFR 441.304)

 Federal law mandates 30-day notice to ensure timeliness

 Your comments are VALUABLE in developing and implementing waiver changes!



Why should I take the time to provide public comment?

- Best way for our agency to hear YOUR concerns
- Assist in creating services that are meaningful and effective
- All comments are read AND addressed in the waiver amendments
