NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE CLOSURE

The Deputy Director of the Indiana Civil Rights Commission (ICRC) has administratively dismissed the above-referenced case, for the following reasons: Complainant, Ashley K. Baker, filed a complaint against Respondent, Kindred Healthcare d/b/a Regency Place of Greenfield, with the ICRC on July 28, 2005. As a result of Complainant and Respondent engaging in settlement discussions, the Complainant has signed a settlement agreement withdrawing her complaint due to her satisfaction of the agreement.

Complainant may request, in writing, an appeal of this finding. 910 IAC 1-3-2. The written appeal request must be filed with the Indiana Civil Rights Commission within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this Notice of Finding and must include any and additional evidence relied on by Complainant to support the appeal.
