Although women have made tremendous gains politically, socially, and in the workforce, they continue to lag far behind their male counterparts. In Indiana, women are 61% of the workforce but still only make \$.72 for every dollar earned by men in comparable positions. That means each woman loses between \$700,000 and \$2 million in her lifetime. Women also feel the burden of an unequal economic structure in other ways. For example, women, particularly single mothers and their children, are disproportionately affected by poverty.
