# Clark-Floyd Landfill Solid Waste Facility Major Modification Permit Application

### Description:

- Clark-Floyd Landfill, LLC, along with Clark County and Floyd County Boards of Commissioners (applicants) are proposing a vertical expansion at the existing landfill, located approximately one mile west of Wilson on State Road 60, in Clark County, Indiana.
- On October 19, 2010, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) received a permit application for the above-referenced facility modification. On January 14, 2011, IDEM issued a letter deeming the application complete and initiating the public participation process.
- The proposed facility will be designed to accept municipal solid waste.
- The proposed Clark-Floyd Landfill vertical expansion will contain approximately 7.9 million cubic yards of airspace for disposal and will extend the planned facility life by approximately 18 years. This fact sheet briefly describes the proposed facility, and the solid waste permitting process.

### Environmental Impacts:

- The proper disposal of regulated solid waste protects Hoosiers and our environment by preventing the accidental release of harmful pollutants to air, land and water.
- The facility design is expected to meet or exceed the requirements of the applicable Title 329 IAC Article 10 Rules for Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) facilities by including a subsurface barrier wall around the entire primary unit with a perimeter leachate collection system, a groundwater monitoring system and a composite lined final cover system.

### The Permitting Process:

- The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) is responsible for protecting human health and the environment while providing for safe industrial, agricultural, commercial and governmental operations vital to a prosperous economy.
- IDEM's Office of Land Quality (OLQ) is responsible for administering the state's solid waste regulations (329 IAC 10). OLQ chemists, geologists and engineers evaluate permit applications for compliance with the regulations before reaching a final decision about the permit for the proposed expansion.
- By statute, IDEM has 365 days to act on a major modification permit application for a solid waste disposal facility. If IDEM requires additional information to evaluate the application, a Request for Additional Information (RAI) is issued and the review clock is suspended until the requested information is submitted to IDEM.
- Correspondence and information relative to the solid waste facility is available for public review through IDEM's Virtual File Cabinet (VFC).

**Public Hearing:**

IDEM will hold a public hearing if there is a significant degree of public interest in the proposal. Petitions or other requests should be sent to Kelly Hall at the address given above for submitting public comments. IDEM will respond to all public comments once a permit decision is made. IDEM will consider public comments that are relevant to the environmental protection acts and the requirements of 329 IAC 10.
