Our office received your NPDES Notice of Intent (NOI) on December 15, 2023, requesting modification of general permit coverage for the above-referenced facility. We are pleased to inform you that the submittal is sufficient to comply with the NOI requirements for 327 IAC 15-7 and that your facility's permit coverage will be modified as follows:

The mine drainage status of Outfall 034 will change from alkaline to acidic.

We have reviewed your request and have determined that the activities associated with it will not violate the antidegradation rules as set forth in 327 IAC 2-1.3. Our office has further determined that the request will not affect this facility's eligibility for coverage under the general permit rules outlined in 327 IAC 15-1 through 15-4 and 327 IAC 15-7, Facilities Engaged in Mining of Coal, Coal Processing, and Reclamation Activities. Therefore, your petition to obtain permit coverage as is described in your NOI has been approved in accordance with Indiana rules promulgated under 327 IAC15-7 and 327 IAC 2-1.3. Coverage for the facility will include all outfalls listed on the first table of Attachment 1 to this correspondence.

The NPDES general permit identification number assigned to this facility has not changed and is referenced above. The <u>effective date for the change in mine</u> <u>drainage status is deemed January 1, 2024</u> and expiration date for this facility's general permit coverage is <u>June 30, 2028</u>. You are required to follow all terms and conditions of 327 IAC 15-7. To receive authorization to discharge beyond this date, you must submit a renewal NOI to IDEM no later than ninety (90) days prior to the date of expiration.

Please note that IDEM is required to serve notice of its decision to accept your facility's modification of coverage under the general permit in accordance with the requirements of 327 IAC 5-3-14. Any appeal must be filed under procedures outlined in IC 13-15-6, IC 4-21.5, and the enclosed Public Notice. The appeal must be initiated by filing a petition for administrative review with the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA) within fifteen (15) days of the emailing of an electronic copy of this letter or within eighteen (18) days of the mailing of this letter. MODIFICATION OF GENERAL PERMIT COVERAGE under 327 IAC 15-7

PEABODY MIDWEST MINING, LLC, WILD BOAR MINE, NPDES General Permit Coverage No. ING040231, located at 566 Dickeyville Rd., Lynnville, IN (**WARRICK COUNTY**). This facility is an active surface coal mine (DNR Permit # S-0360). The permittee submitted a Notice of Intent to request modification of its general NPDES permit coverage under 327 IAC 15-7 for Facilities Engaged in the Mining of Coal, Coal Processing, and Reclamation Activities. The modification includes the change of mine drainage status of Outfall 034 from alkaline to acid. This modification is deemed effective January 1, 2024. Notice of Right to Administrative Review

If you wish to challenge this permit, you must file a Petition for Administrative Review with the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA) and serve a copy of the petition upon IDEM. The requirements for filing a Petition for Administrative Review are found in IC 4-21.5-3-7, IC 13-15-6-1 and 315 IAC 1-3-2. A summary of the requirements of these laws is provided below.

A Petition for Administrative Review must be filed with the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA) within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this notice (eighteen (18) days if you received this notice by U.S. Mail), and a copy must be served upon IDEM. Addresses are:

The petition must contain the following information:

- 1. The name, address and telephone number of each petitioner.
- 2. A description of each petitioner's interest in the permit.
- 3. A statement of facts demonstrating that each petitioner is:
 - a. a person to whom the order is directed;
 - b. aggrieved or adversely affected by the permit; or
 - c. entitled to administrative review under any law.
- 4. The reasons for the request for administrative review.
- 5. The particular legal issues proposed for review.
- 6. The alleged environmental concerns or technical deficiencies of the permit.
- 7. The permit terms and conditions that the petitioner believes would be appropriate and would comply with the law.
- 8. The identity of any persons represented by the petitioner.
- 9. The identity of the person against whom administrative review is sought.
- 10. A copy of the permit that is the basis of the petition.
- 11. A statement identifying petitioner's attorney or other representative, if any.

Failure to meet the requirements of the law with respect to a Petition for Administrative Review may result in a waiver of your right to seek administrative review of the permit. Examples are:

- 1. Failure to file a Petition by the applicable deadline;
- 2. Failure to serve a copy of the Petition upon IDEM when it is filed; or
- 3. Failure to include the information required by law.

If you seek to have a permit stayed during the administrative review, you may need to file a Petition for a Stay of Effectiveness. The specific requirements for such a Petition can be found in 315 IAC 1-3-2 and 315 IAC 1-3-2.1.

Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-17, OEA will provide all parties with notice of any pre-hearing conferences, preliminary hearings, hearings, stays, or orders disposing of the review of this action. Peabody Midwest Mining, LLC, submits this notice of intent to comply with 327 IAC 15-7 regulating facilities engaged in mining of coal, coal processing and reclamation activities. We are requesting the following change to the NPDES permit:

1. Reclassify Outfall 034 as Acid. Outfall 034 is currently permitted as Alkaline, unconstructed. No disturbed drainage reports to Outfall 034 at this time. Water from RB010, will be pumped to Basin 034. Refuse basin RB010 is a gob and slurry disposal area. Due to refuse disposal activities, Peabody Midwest Mining requests that Outfall 034 be reclassified as Acid. Ms. Phyllis Hart, the Division of Reclamation inspector at Wild Boar Mine, has been notified of the change.

- (A) state the name and address of the person making the request;
- (B) identify the interest of the person making the request;

- (D) state with particularity the reasons for the request;
- (E) state with particularity the issues proposed for consideration at the hearing; and
