

RESOLUTION 1999-24

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE REQUEST OF GDC, INC. TO WITHDRAW ITS APPLICATION FOR A SUPPLIER'S LICENSE.

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6:

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. On or about July 19, 1995, GDC, Inc. submitted an application for a supplier's license to the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission").
2. On November 17, 1995, the Commission granted GDC, Inc. a Temporary Supplier's License.
3. On October 22, 1997, the Commission granted GDC, Inc. a Permanent Supplier's License.
4. On February 22, 1999, the Commission granted GDC, Inc. a Renewal of their Permanent Supplier's License.
5. The Commission received a written letter from GDC, Inc. announcing that GDC, Inc. would cease doing business in the USA by the end of July 1999 (copy of letter attached).
6. GDC, Inc. is in good standing with the Commission at the time of the request to withdraw its Supplier's License and there are no pending disciplinary actions filed against GDC, Inc. by the Commission.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING
COMMISSION THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to GDC, Inc.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. REQUEST TO WITHDRAW.

The request of GDC, Inc. to withdraw its application for a Permanent Supplier's License received on October 22, 1997, and renewed on February 22, 1999, is hereby:



This resolution is effective immediately.


