### Watt High Light News Letter:

Jackson County REMC has asked the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission to approve an increases in its metered rates that are based solely upon cost of purchased electricity that are being charged by Jackson's power supplier, Hoosier Energy, Inc., headquartered in Bloomington, Indiana.

The request of a \$2.96 per 1,000 kWh increase stems from a pending July 1, 2009 quarterly increase in Hoosier's power cost tracker to cover the net increase in costs for energy fuels, market power purchases, and other highly fluctuating expenses.

The overall impact of the increase will raise a typical Jackson REMC bill of 1,000 kWh from \$103.12 to \$106.08, an increase of 2.87 percent.

As submitted, the new rates will become effective on July 1, 2009, and should first appear on bills mailed on August 31, due and payable by September 17. The REMC directors and management of the cooperative emphasize that only the rising costs of wholesale electricity are included in the rate adjustment. The REMC will not retain any of the revenue generated by the higher rates.
