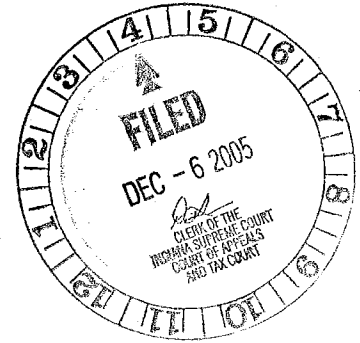

**ORDER INCREASING SENIOR JUDGE SERVICE DAYS  
FOR THE DELAWARE CIRCUIT COURT 5**

The presiding judge of the Delaware Circuit Court 5 has requested an increase in senior judge service days for the calendar years 2005 and 2006

This Court adopted revisions to Administrative Rule 5 on December 3, 2003, which made certain changes to the senior judge program in recognition of the importance of senior judges to the administration of justice in Indiana trial courts. Accordingly, we find that the Delaware Circuit Court 5 has demonstrated the need for additional judicial resources based on the circumstances presented by that court, and would benefit from additional senior judge service days to assist with those circumstances. This Court may re-examine this increase at a later date in light of weighted caseload statistics and other circumstances, and make adjustments accordingly.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the allocation of senior judge service days for the Delaware Circuit Court 5 be increased to forty-five (45) days, to be utilized at the

discretion of the presiding judge of the Delaware Circuit Court 5 for both the calendar year 2005 and the calendar year 2006.

The Clerk of this Court is directed to forward a certified copy of this order to the Honorable Wayne J. Lenington, presiding judge of the Delaware Circuit Court 5; to the clerk of the Delaware Circuit Court, for entry in the Record of Judgments and Orders; to the Indiana Judicial Center; to the Judicial Qualifications Commission; and to the Division of State Court Administration, Payroll Section.
