Indiana Brownfields Program Basics

- □ # of Program sites: approximately 1,100
 - Active sites: approximately 200
 - Closures in past two years: 64 (NFAs issued)
 - Liability clarifications in past two years: 176 (CL/SSL/NFA issued)
- □ Initial funding sources:
 - > \$10M Hazardous Substances Response Trust Fund (1998)
 - > \$9M Excess Liability Trust Fund (2001)


Indiana Brownfields Program Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) & Brownfields ARRA Summary



- □ \$4,039,000 LUST ARRA grant awarded by EPA on 8/4/09
- □ 31 petroleum sites cleaned up, 4 underway
 - 85 Underground Storage Tanks removed
 - 2 Aboveground Storage Tanks & 7 fuel oil underground storage tanks removed (with state petroleum remediation grant (PRG) funds)
 - 11 Hydraulic Lifts removed (with state PRG funds)
 - 26,092 tons of petroleum-impacted soil removed
 - 32,979 gallons of petroleum-impacted liquid removed
 - 29 No Further Action letters issued, 2 in process
- \$2,500,000 Brownfields ARRA RLF grant awarded by EPA on 9/30/09
- → 4 loans; \$2,350,000
 - 22.92 acres ready for redevelopment
 - 12,053 tons of contaminated soil removed
 - 20,870 gallons contaminated liquids removed
 - 6 Underground Storage Tanks removed
 - 1 Site Status Letter issued


Indiana Brownfields Program Total Awards FY 1997 – 2009 (through June 30, 2009) \$36,094,208





Indiana Brownfields Program Total Awards FY 2010 – 2012 (July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2012) \$4,751,389






Indiana Brownfields Program Project Funding Mix (1997 – 2012) Actual Funds Leveraged for *IFA-funded Projects*



Indiana Brownfields Program IEDC Cooperation




- Several of the State's significant economic development deals have transpired on contaminated sites

- Examples: Progress Rail in Muncie (former ABB/Westinghouse facility) & Cummins expansion in Seymour (former INDOT garage)
- Liability clarification letters play a critical role in helping companies reach a comfort level in bringing their business to a brownfields site
