The portion of the cigarette tax dedicated to the retiree health benefit plan is being redirected to the general fund for FY 2012 and FY 2013 only. These funds are being redirected to reimburse the General Fund for expenses incurred in prior years while ensuring the plan remains more than 100% actuarially funded.

3. Year-to-date revenues of motor vehicle excise taxes, commercial vehicle excise taxes, and financial institution taxes under HEA 1001-2008 totaled \$30.5 M. Due to the difficulty of determining the timing of these revenues, they are being deposited in a separate fund and will be reported as General Fund forecast revenue in June 2012.

4. The targets for the budget plan are based on the April 15, 2011, revenue forecast adjusted for the impact of legislative actions taken by the General Assembly in 2011.

5. In December 2011, Indiana Department of Revenue's internal audit recognized that an error has led to an understatement of corporate tax revenues. The corporate tax revenues for Jul to November 2011 have been restated to reflect these revenues.
